#### Pacific Southwest Region National Forests in California

- California's National Forests encompass 20 million acres in 18 national forests.
- These lands produce about 45% of the state's water.
- Forest management is directed by a forest plan these are currently being revised in 3 phases: (1) assessment, (2) plan revision, & (3) monitoring
