The Delta Landscapes Project (funded by CA Department of Fish & Wildlife) offers new insights into the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta, examining how to achieve better restoration outcomes by understanding how the natural systems originally functioned. Given the complexities of the restoration efforts and the large number of agencies and stakeholders involved, in-person dialog among restoration practitioners, landowners and regulators is necessary to adapt the scientific findings into a usable framework for on-the-ground decision-making.

At this Delta Landscapes briefing, participants will test-run and provide feedback on a user's guide that can be used to integrate the technical findings of the Delta Landscapes Project for use by the Delta community.

This workshop is for:

- ▶ **Restoration practitioners** wondering how their project fits into a larger landscape
- ▶ **Delta landowners** wondering how to improve wildlife habitat in strategic places
- ▶ **Regulators** from local government, state and federal agencies wondering about the appropriateness of a permit application
