

Native Perennial Grasslands



Ridger-Roller Seeder was fabricated to apply native grass seed to levee slopes.



Over 850 acres of levee, seepage berm, and habitat areas were seeded with native perennial grasses.



Over 10 acres of native forbs were planted to provide habitat for pollinators and other beneficial insects.

Riparian Woodlands



More than 1200 valley oaks were transplanted from the levee footprint.



More than 140 acres of riparian woodlands were planted and/or preserved.

Giant Garter Snake Canal



The 4.5 mile giant garter snake (GGS) canal provides habitat and connectivity for GGS.

Swainson's Hawk Foraging Habitat



150 acres of agricultural land preservation to provide Swainson's hawk foraging habitat.

Fisherman's Lake GGS Marsh Complex



Over 150 acres of marsh and upland habitat for GGS. Located contiguous to existing marshes.
