

Regional Water Authority

- Joint powers authority formed in 2001
- Representation of regional water interests
- Assist in regional implementation of some Water Forum Agreement elements
- 22 water supply agencies and 3 associates
- Public agency, with elected representatives



Local IRWM Effort


- In April 2004, RWA started development of a regional water master plan
- DWR released IRWM guidelines in Nov 2004
- Initial IRWM Plan adopted May 2006 in compliance with DWR guidelines
 - Water supplier driven
- Current IRWM Plan update began in 2009
 - RWA approved by DWR as RWMG in mid-2009
 - First stakeholder meeting November 2009
- Adopt IRWM Plan update in July 2013

IRWM Update

Stakeholders/Outreach

- 8 planning/stakeholder forums
 - Over 175 people on distribution list
 - Average of ~30 per forum
- 12 work group meetings on topics:
 - Stormwater quality
 - Watershed management
 - Climate change
 - Water supply/demand management
 - Agriculture
 - Flood/floodplain management
- 122 distinct individuals have attended at least one meeting
 - ~60 entities represented; <20 water agencies
 - 48 individuals have attended at least three meetings
